WEBSITE TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. About Taste Me Up

Taste Me Up Ltd ("Taste Me Up", "we", "us" or "our") provides kosher catering, event catering, food, beverage and related event services in the United Kingdom. These Website Terms and Conditions govern your use of our website and provide general information about the basis on which our services are offered.

2. Website Information

Information on this website, including menus, photographs, descriptions, packages, prices, availability and examples of previous work, is provided for general information and may be changed or withdrawn at any time. Photographs are illustrative. The final presentation, ingredients, quantities, equipment, staffing and service arrangements for an event may differ from examples shown online.

3. Enquiries and Bookings

Submitting an enquiry through our website does not create a booking or contract. A booking is only confirmed when Taste Me Up has accepted the booking in writing, the applicable booking documentation has been agreed, and any required deposit or other payment has been received.

Once a client enters into a written booking or event contract with Taste Me Up, that contract will govern the specific event. If there is any conflict between these Website Terms and the signed booking contract, the signed booking contract will take precedence.

4. Prices and Payment

Prices displayed on the website are subject to change and may not include every cost associated with an event unless expressly stated. The price, payment schedule, deposit and other financial terms applicable to a particular booking will be set out in the relevant booking contract or quotation.

Where applicable, VAT will be charged at the rate required by law.

5. Menus, Ingredients and Substitutions

We may make reasonable changes to menus or ingredients where required because of availability, seasonality, supplier issues, food safety, dietary requirements or circumstances outside our reasonable control. We will seek to maintain the agreed character and quality of the service.

Clients must provide accurate information about allergies, intolerances and dietary requirements within the timescales specified in their booking documentation. Dietary requirements should not be assumed to have been communicated merely because they have been mentioned during an informal conversation.

6. Kashrut

Where a service is described as kosher, the applicable level and supervision of kashrut will be as stated in the relevant quotation or booking contract. Specific kashrut arrangements, supervision fees and requirements may vary between events and venues.

7. Client and Venue Responsibilities

The client is responsible for providing accurate event information and, where applicable, ensuring that the venue permits access, catering, equipment, cooking, preparation and service at the agreed times. Additional costs caused by restricted access, delays, venue requirements, changes in timings or circumstances outside Taste Me Up's control may be chargeable where permitted by the booking contract.

8. Cancellation and Changes

Cancellation, postponement, changes to guest numbers, menu changes and changes to event timings are governed by the booking contract applicable to the event. Nothing on this website replaces or reduces any contractual cancellation or payment obligations agreed in that contract.

9. Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise stated, the website and its content, including text, photographs, graphics, branding, logos, menus and other materials, are owned by or licensed to Taste Me Up and must not be copied, reproduced or commercially used without our prior written permission.

10. Website Availability

We do not guarantee that the website will always be available, uninterrupted or error-free. We may suspend, withdraw or change the website or any part of it without notice.

11. Liability

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability that cannot lawfully be excluded or limited, including liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation, or any other liability which cannot be excluded by law.

Subject to the above, Taste Me Up will not be responsible for losses that are not reasonably foreseeable or for matters outside our reasonable control. The specific allocation of risk and liability for an event will be set out in the applicable booking contract.

12. Third-Party Services

We may use third-party suppliers, venues, payment providers, website providers and other service providers in delivering our services. Their own terms and privacy policies may apply where relevant.

13. Privacy

Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect and use personal information. Our Privacy Policy forms part of the information available on this website but does not replace the terms of any event booking contract.

14. Governing Law

These Terms are governed by the laws of England and Wales. Any dispute relating to these Terms will be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales, unless applicable law requires otherwise.
